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Introduction to Machine Sewing

The pattern used is provided by the teacher and becomes the property of the student. Teacher will provide fusible interfacing.



- Fabric must be woven cotton or cotton-blend fabric like quilting cotton. Please avoid home décor fabric, plaid fabric and fabric with one-way design (fabric with definite up and down direction to the pattern).
- For apron made of only one fabric, 1 3/8 yards of 45" or 60" wide fabric.
- For an apron made with contrasting fabrics, as in picture, 1 1/4 yd. of 45" or 60" wide fabric and 1/2 yard contrasting fabric.
- 1 spool of sewing thread of matching color. 100% polyester or cotton/poly thread. Be sure to get regular sewing weight thread. DO NOT BUY quilting thread, heavyduty thread, or shiny embroidery thread as these are not suitable for regular machine sewing.
- Dressmaker's shears. Household scissors are not usually sharp enough for cutting fabric.
- · Sewing pins.

Helpful but not necessary:

- Water-soluble marking pencil.
- Seam gauge, small ruler, or tape measure.
