 - Physical parking permits are no longer issued. Your vehicle's license plate serves as your parking permit.
 - After purchasing a permit, complete the online vehicle registration form to associate your permit with your vehicle's license plate.
 - A parking permit is only needed if you're taking daytime class(es) at ISU.
 - Passes are valid from the date purchased until August 31, 2027.
