



## ASSISTANCE WITH MEDICATIONS- Online

Dear Agency/ Facility/ Student

Thank you for registering for the Assistance with Medications online course with in-person skills testing. The date you have registered for is for skills testing. The online course must be completed before skills testing and the completion letter found within the online course must be printed and presented to the instructor at skills testing. Students will not be allowed to attend skills testing without the letter.

### ONLINE Training:

- Students will complete the AWM course within our online Moodle system. This course will include a lecture presentation with evaluation questions, skills videos, learning activities and a written test.
- Students will need access to a computer with internet access and with access to the **Firefox** browser. (Other browsers may not work properly).
- The course can be accessed at: <https://cettrain.isu.edu/account/login/>
- Students who have previously taken online classes from us can use the email they have registered with to log in. If they are unable to log in or have never logged into the system they will need to use the “**Reset Password**” option. DO NOT create another profile.
- ALL portions will need to be completed and a passing score of 80% or better on the written exam before skills testing.
- Students who do not pass the written exam with an 80% will be given the opportunity to retake the entire the course for \$20.
- Students will be provided a letter upon completion of online course. This will need to be need be given to the agency prior to skills testing.

### SKILLS Demonstration and Testing:

- Students will learn skills using online skills videos and skills outlines found in the Student Guide within the course and in the handout section:

- Skills Testing will be conducted in person on the scheduled date.
- Students will need to fill out a Health Screening Questionnaire and a temperature will be taken. Students will wear a mask and abide by social distancing guidelines.
