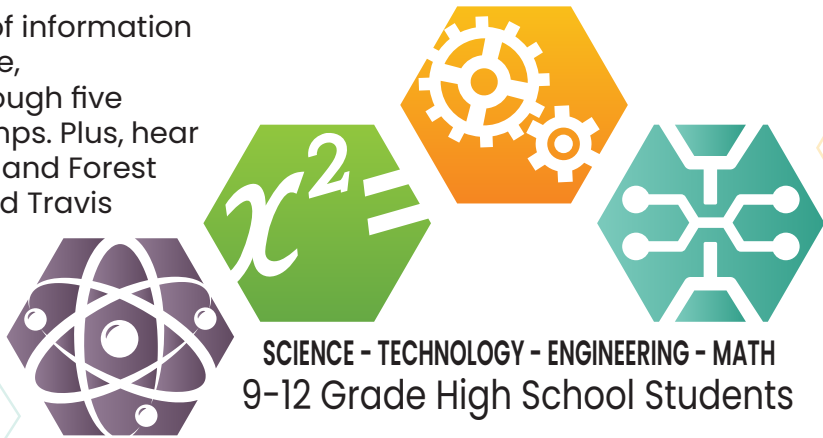


# Ignite Their Future SUMMER CAMP
